Each member may sell one steer at the sale.



STEERS AND BREEDING CATTLE

1. Steers must be owned by February 11 and born between January 1 and September 1, 2006.
2. Breeding stock must be owned by April 1.
3. Steer weigh-in Feb. 10, 2007 at Howard County Vet. Services. All steers must weigh-in. If you are unable to make the date set you will have to make prior arrangements to have them weighed between Feb. 3-17.
4. Steers must be nosed printed to show at the state fair. Check state fair book for more information.
5. All cattle must be pre-registered and show expectation letter signed. A copy of the breed registration paper must be turned in to the Howard County Extension Center by June 1. If no registration paper is on file the exhibit will show as a crossbred. Forms must be returned to the Howard County Extension Center by June 1. Forms are at the end of the livestock section of the fair book.
6. Exhibitors help is appreciated in setting up and taking down the barn. Set-up on _____, 2007. Take down Saturday, July 14, 2007.
7. An individual may show more than one steer but only one will be sold at the fair sale. Heaviest qualifying steer will be sold at the sale unless the show clerk is notified immediately after the show.
8. Minimum weight for steers to sell in the fair sale is 900 lbs.
9. Eligibility of miniature beef breeds will be determined by a special beef committee. (i.e. –Irish Dexter, Miniature Belgian Blue, etc.)
10. All Steers will be stalled by 4-H/FFA club that exhibitor is a member of. See Herdsmanship information on next page.
11. **There will be NO GLUE, NO ADHESIVE, or NO COLOR allowed at this show. Failure to follow these rules will result in disqualification. FITTERS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO GROOM.** Exhibitor must fit their own animal. Immediate Family members or another Howard County 4-H or FFA exhibitor may assist.
12. All cattle must be broke to lead. If the Beef superintendent feels that the safety of others is in danger they will ask that the exhibit be removed and not allowed to show.
13. To show in a breed class exhibit must have Identification Papers (as required by National Breed Association). A copy of the registration paper must be returned to the Howard County Extension Center by June 1 If

less than three steers are in a breed class they will either be showed in an all-breed class or the crossbred class depending on the numbers.

14. All cattle staying over night must have neck ropes.
