



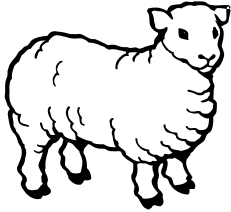
4-H/FFA Sheep Show

Sheep alternate with goats, hams, hogs, rabbits, chickens and steers in the sale.
Each member may sell one market lamb at the sale.

Champion is ask to stay until 5:00 p.m. Saturday, July 12.



1. Sheep must be owned by May 10
2. Market lamb weigh-in May 10th, 2008 at Howard County Vet. Services. All market lambs must weigh-in. If you are unable to make the date set you will have to make prior arrangements to have them weighed between May 3-17.
3. All sheep must be pre-registered and show expectation letter signed. Registration Forms must be returned to the Howard County Extension Center by June 1. Forms are at the end of the livestock section of the fair book.
4. All exhibitors must be **SMQA Certified**.
5. All exhibits must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (health Certificate) to be eligible to show. This health certificate must have been written within 30 days of exhibition. All sheep and goats must also be identified either by ear tag, electronic implant or tattoo.
6. Exhibitors help is appreciated in setting up the barn. Set-up on Monday, July 7, 2008.
7. **All exhibits must be in place by 12:00 p.m. Thursday, July 10, 2008.**
8. Exhibitor must groom and care for their animal.
9. An individual may show two market sheep but only one will be sold at the fair sale. Heaviest qualifying market animal will be sold at the sale unless the show clerk is notified immediately after the show.
10. Minimum weight for market sheep to sell in the fair sale is 90 lbs.
11. All Sheep will be stalled by 4-H/FFA club that exhibitor is a member of.
12. Eligibility of miniature sheep breeds will be determined by a special sheep committee.
