

Miss Howard County Teen Rules and Regulations

1. Contestant shall be a citizen of the United States.
2. Contestant shall be a resident of Howard County to be eligible to compete for the title of Miss Howard County Teen.
3. Contestant shall be not less than 12, nor more than 16 years of age as of the date of the pageant. She may not be eligible to compete in the Howard County Queen (Miss Howard County) competition.
4. Contestant shall be female and never have been married or have children.
5. A complete entry will include the following:
 - a. \$25 entry fee
 - b. completed fact sheet and biographical information which clearly represents contestant's true and actual background
 - c. selection of a talent which can be performed within a 3-minute time frame (completed talent form)
 - d. one 5X7 and one wallet-sized color or B&W photograph or photocopy
6. Conduct deemed to be improper and detrimental to the Howard County Fair or the queen pageant will be reason for disqualification and dismissal by the fair board.
7. Miss Howard County Teen must be able to reign over the Howard County Fair for the year of her title.
8. Miss Howard County Teen will not be expected to assume any further obligations after the fair except to give up her title the following year at the Howard County Fair Queen contest.
9. Contestant agrees that the time, manner, and method of judging shall be at the discretion of the Howard County Fair and the decision of the judges will be final.
10. Contestants will compete in the categories of interview, talent, and party/evening wear. Interview will be a private interview with the judges. Talent and party/evening wear will competitions will take place on stage at the Howard County Fair Queen Contest.

Scoring: Interview – 1/3
 Talent - 1/3
 Party/evening wear - 1/3
